

GUIDELINES GOVERNING SPOT ADMISSION 2026-27

- ✓ Students, who have passed Higher Secondary Final Examination, qualify for spot admission into FYUG 1st Semester in the academic session of 2026-27 from 15 to 17 June 2026.
- ✓ Before spot admission, aspiring applicants need to go online and get registered on the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) from 13 June onwards till 17 June 2026 (4 P.M.).
- ✓ Applicants who have already registered themselves on the Admission Portal and possess a Valid Samarth Registration Number are not required to register again.
- ✓ **Admission would be on first-come-first-serve basis.**
- ✓ Owing to heavy rush for admission into specific departments of S. K. Roy College (departments such as Bengali and Political Science) during the previous two phases of admission through 1st and 2nd Merit List(s) and the resultant near saturation of the intake capacity of such departments, applicants for such departments may have to switch to other departments of the college wherein availability of seats prevail.

In other words, under circumstances of overcrowding and saturation of intake capacity in specific departments, applicants, during their spot appearance in our institution, may need to change their 1st Subject (Discipline Specific Core [DSC]), 2nd Subject (Discipline Specific Minor -1 [DSM-1]) and 3rd Subject (Discipline Specific Minor -2 [DSM-2]) as per availability of seats in other departments of the institution.

For this, they need to once again go online and change their already selected options for Subject 1, Subject 2 and Subject 3 on the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) and choose from the remaining available subject options under S. K. Roy College, Katlicherra.

- ✓ **As per guidelines from our affiliating authority (Assam University, Silchar), applicants cannot choose more than one language subjects.**

In S. K. Roy College, Katlicherra, there are three language subjects available: Bengali, English and Persian. So, an applicant who chooses any one of these three language subjects, cannot further choose from the remaining two.

Even if an applicant unmindfully or inadvertently chooses more than one language subjects and the same process is allowed on the Samarth Admission Portal, she/he would be facing complications in subject combinations while registering afterwards under Assam University, Silchar (<https://www.ausexamination.ac.in/admission/>).

- ✓ Besides selection of Subject 1, Subject 2 and Subject 3, applicants need to fill up a Consent Form on the spot in order to select Subject 4 (Interdisciplinary Course [IDC]), along with a Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) as per their respective DSC Subject and a Value-Added Course (VAC) as per options available in the college. Moreover, they need to take Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) which is a compulsory course for all applicants.
- ✓ For spot admission, applicants need to bring with them the originals of all of their educational testimonials from HSLC onwards (including Mark-Sheets/ Grade Cards, and Certificates) for verification by the college authority.

Applicants also need to bring photocopies of their testimonials along with a printout of their Samarth Registration Form for submission to the college office.

They need to bring a copy their AADHAAR along with the original.

Besides, applicants seeking free admission need additionally to bring Guardian's Income Certificate procured from competent authority. In the absence of Income Certificate, they can bring Family Ration Card. However, the Ration Card must contain either the applicants' own name or that of their mother and father.

- ✓ In all matters related to Spot Admission 2026-27, the decision of the College Authority shall be final and binding.
